What is GTT?

In response to data on current priorities, Hambleton and Richmond Locality Board are utilising school improvement funding to support schools to develop and refine their pedagogy. Licences for The Great Teaching Toolkit (GTT), based on research by Professor Rob Coe and the University of Cambridge, will be made available, free of charge for schools who wish to take up this offer.

The GTT is more than a short-term 'standalone' training package. It is an evidence-based and sustained commitment to developing teaching quality over time. It is professional development, but not as you know it. To use the toolkit is to be part of a community that itself is contributing to a new body of knowledge on the things that teachers and leaders can do to demonstrably improve. The toolkit contains training videos, audits and feedback tools to support development.
