

# Transition Impact Report (2022-23)

Impact evaluation surveys from young people will show that at least half are 100% more confident in the school.

100% of CYP attending will receive a Unit Award

School staff will notice an increase in confidence and 60% increase in attendance for the 4 weeks after the course has ended.

Support staff accompanying students have access to Thrive Practitioner with group action plan for further work to continue in school.


